Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all his pleas before the trial court at the appropriate stage. He, however, submits that considering the nature of dispute, the trial court may be directed to decide the same expeditiously.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. It is directed that the trial court would endeavour to conclude the trial expeditiously. In the eventuality petitioner himself complies with the order dated 31.5.2016, passed by the trial court, directing the parties (co-sharers) to get water from the tubewell as per their share, police assistance may not be necessary. Nothing said herein above, shall have any bearing on the merits of the case.
