REKHA MITTAL, J.(Oral)

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the trial Court on 03.11.2016 recorded statement of Jai Bhagwan –defendant No.1 but did not pass any order either to allow or disallow an interim relief. He has further submitted that even the Court did not record contentions of the petitioner on the basis whereof the plaintiff has sought the relief of permanent injunction with a prayer for interim stay. It is prayed that petition may be disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to dispose of the application for grant of ad interim injunction in a time-bound manner.

Without commenting upon merits of the case and in view of the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to dispose of the application for ad interim injunction within a period of 15 days from the date of service of remaining defendants i.e. defendants No.2 to 5.
