REKHA MITTAL, J.

The present petition directs challenge against orders dated 9.5.2016 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Talwandi Sabo (Annexure P-5) and dated 3.10.2016 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Additional District Judge, Bathinda whereby application filed by the respondent/plaintiff for grant of interim injunction has been allowed by the trial court and the order passed by the trial court has been affirmed in appeal.

Counsel for the petitioner would submit that he does not press the petition on merits but without prejudice to rights of the petitioner to raise all available pleas during trial but some direction may be issued to the trial court to dispose of the suit expeditiously as the petitioner is claiming right in the suit property on the basis of a registered sale deed.

In view of the above, without examining merits of the controversy, the petition stands disposed of without prejudice to rights of the petitioner to raise all available pleas before the trial court. However, as

the petitioner is claiming rights in the suit property on the basis of a sale deed in her favour that has been challenged by the respondent/plaintiff on the ground of his mental condition, the trial court shall ensure that no unnecessary adjournments are given to the respondent/plaintiff for adducing evidence so that the respondent/plaintiff should not be successful in delay of conclusion of the proceedings by taking advantage of the stay order.
