There is no scope for making an interference with the order already passed eschewing the affidavit of evidence given by the Principal when the power of attorney was already cited and examined. Admittedly, no application under Order 18 Rule 3A CPC was filed to examine the witness out of turn before examining the party.

I will make no interference and the revision petition is dismissed.

Counsel for the petitioner says that he will file an application under Order 18 Rule 3A CPC before the trial Court. If any such application is filed, the court will consider the same and pass appropriate orders.
