Counsel for the parties are ad idem that the petition may be disposed of and the petitioner may be permitted to tender into evidence statement of Shish Ram plaintiff-respondent No.1 recorded in the earlier proceedings between the parties but its evidentiary value may be left to be decided by the trial Court.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of. The trial Court shall permit the petitioner/defendant to tender into evidence statement of Shish Ram plaintiff-respondent No.1 recorded in the Court in earlier litigation between the parties subject to payment of cost of Rs.5,000/- to the contesting respondent at the time of tendering of document. However, the evidentiary value of the said document would be appreciated by the trial Court at the time of final disposal of the suit.
