A short prayer in the present petition filed under Section 227 of the Constitution of India to take up and decide the application dated 13.11.2014 (Annexure P-6) pending adjudication before respondent No.2 before finalizing the award.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the application filed for settlement is maintainable under Section 30 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act. He further states that he will be satisfied in case the respondent No.2 is directed to decide the application dated 13.11.2014 (Annexure P-6) before finalizing the award.

The learned counsel for respondent No.1 pleads no objection

in case any direction is issued to the competent authority to decide the application dated 13.11.2014 (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioner.

In the application dated 13.11.2014 (Annexure P-6) certain amount which are not paid by the petitioner have been indicated. It will be in the interest of both the parties if the issue raised by the petitioner in Annexure P-6 be settled before finalization of the Award.

Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide application dated 13.11.2014 (Annexure P-6), before finalization of the Award, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
