The counsel for the petitioner on instructions from the party who is present in Court states that he will make the payment of Rs. 4,80,157/- which the decree holder is prepared to receive in full quit of all claims against the judgment debtor. Accordingly, the decree will stand discharged and full satisfaction recorded. If the amount is not paid in the manner undertaken before this Court, the further process in execution will continue.

The civil revision petition is disposed of as requiring no further orders. The payment shall be in the manner of deposit to the credit of the account of the suit before the respondent-Bank itself.

Needless to state, the petitioner will have the right of proceeding against the judgment debtor either by means of independent suit or proceedings by resort to Order 8A of the Civil Procedure Code.
