The petitioners have not availed the remedy available to them to move the application under Order 39 Rule 4 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (for short 'CPC') for vacation/modification of the injunction order even though, they have appeared before the learned First Appellate Court on 22.10.2015 and the present revision petition has been filed after more than one year from the date of the injunction order.

So, the present revision petition is hereby dismissed. The petitioners will be at liberty to avail the remedy available to them for moving the requisite application to the learned First Appellate Court for vacation/modification of the injunction order. If, any such application is moved, that shall be adjudicated upon by the learned First Appellate Court in accordance with law.
