The present petition directs challenge against order dated 3.10.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by the trial court as an interim measure whereby electric connection of the respondent/plaintiff is ordered to re-connected subject to deposit of 50% of Rs. 1,05,06,111/- towards consumption charges and Rs. 27,80,000/- as compounding fee.

Counsel for the petitioners has apprised the court that in pursuance of interim directions issued by the trial court, connection has

already been re-connected as the respondent/petitioner has deposited half of the amount in compliance of order passed by the trial court.

Needless to say that the court allowed re-connection of electric supply as an interim measure and the application for grant of ad interim injunction is yet to be decided by the Court. That being so, the present petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to raise all available pleas including furnishing of a bank guarantee by the respondent/plaintiff with regard to the remaining amount till disposal of the suit, before the trial court. The petitioners would further be at liberty to vindicate their grievance in appropriate proceedings in case their plea in this regard is not accepted by the trial court.
