Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has filed the petition for claiming the visiting rights to his minor son, who is in the custody of his divorced wife. He contended that no doubt the custody of the child was transferred to the wife as a result of settlement in the divorce petition, but the petitioner is entitled for visitation right. He further contended that the petitioner has filed petition on 5.4.2013. The reply to the application was filed on 1.11.2013. The trial court has taken about two years in framing the issues.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has undertaken that the petitioner will conclude his evidence within three months from the next date of hearing fixed before the learned trial court. He has pleaded that the present petition may be disposed of with some specific direction to the trial court to dispose of the main petition expeditiously.

So, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the learned Guardian Court/Trial Court to dispose of the petition filed by the petitioner within eight months from the next date of hearing fixed before it.
