Parties are present in Court.

This petition has been filed against the order dated 12.01.2016 fixing mesne profits. With the intervention of learned counsel for the parties, main dispute has been resolved.

Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that the petitioner is willing to voluntarily vacate the premises on or before 7.4.2017 without forcing the landlord to file an execution petition.

Counsel for the respondents, on instructions, states that the respondent-landlord would have no objection in allowing the petitioner to

retain the premises till 7.4.2017 subject to the condition that she pays rent for the period 1.3.2016 to 7.4.2017 @ ₹ 30,000/- per month in advance by the 7th of every month, and also continues to pay the other admissible charges regularly, and files an undertaking to this effect before the Appellate Authority.

Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, has accepted these conditions.

This petition is disposed of in the above terms.
