RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.

1. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 states that the order of the Governor of Punjab dated April 23, 1993 (Annexure R-8) with the written statement filed by respondent No.1 has not been disclosed in the petition nor has been challenged while it forecloses the claim of the petitioner by detailed order assigning reasons. In absence of challenge to the order, no relief can be granted to the petitioner and especially at this distance of time.

2. The prayer in the petition was against apprehended reversion from the post of Sub Divisional Engineer on which post the petitioner was promoted by the competent authority after being brought on the select list in 1981. He also claims that his services as SDE be regularized. The further apprehension was that respondents No.3 to 7 were likely to be promoted

whose names are stated to have been earlier rejected by the Departmental Screening Committee.

3. However, the order dated April 23, 1993 speaks to the contrary.

There is no life left in this petition. It is ordered to stand dismissed.
