Learned counsel for the State has filed affidavit of Sh. Davinder Kumar Sidhu, Superintendent, Central Jail, Gurdaspur, mentioning the period of imprisonment undergone by the appellant-Gurmej Singh. The same is taken on record.

As per the custody certificate of the appellant, he was released from Central Jail, Gurdaspur on 13.07.2013 after completing the sentence by giving him benefit of undertrial period, post-conviction period, remission and after depositing the fine at jail gate. In this situation, the learned

counsel for the appellant has contended that this appeal may be disposed of having been rendered infructuous, since the appellant (accused) has already undergone the sentence imposed upon him and has been released from jail after completing his sentence in this case.
