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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This order of mine shall dispose of CRA-S No.1604-SB of 2011 and CRA-S No.1628-SB of 2011.

The affidavits of all the three applicants-appellants-injured, namely Raj Singh, Shinderpal Singh and Jasbir Singh have been filed, who are present in the court today and have affirmed the correctness of the affidavits.

It comes out that Raj Singh and Jasvir Singh were convicted for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 452, 323 and 324 read with Section 34 IPC, whereas in the cross case, Shinderpal has been convicted for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 342, 323, 325 read with Section 34 IPC. All the parties are real brothers.

In the cross case, Shinderpal Singh, Sardul Singh, Avtar Singh and Birbal Singh have been convicted for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 323, 325 and 342 IPC. Now, the parties have compromised the matter. Therefore, the main appeals are ordered to be taken on board and listed for hearing today.

CRM No.11730 of 2016 in CRA-S No.1604-SB of 2011 and CRM No.11743 of 2016 in CRA-S No.1628-SB of 2011 are allowed.

Main Cases

Since, the parties have amicably settled their dispute, therefore, in order to keep good relations between the parties, the sentence of the appellants in both the cases is reduced to the period already undergone by them.

Accordingly, both the appeals stand disposed of.
