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On the last date of hearing i.e. 02.02.2016, learned counsel for respondent No.2 had submitted that the petitioner in this case has lost the right in the property in respect of which, his sewerage connection was declared unauthorized by respondent No.2. In this connection, he has filed report of Water Rate Clerk dated 29.01.2016 and letter No.MCF/DA/2016/08 dated 01.01.2016 from the District Attorney, Municipal Corporation, Faridabad, to the Superintending Engineer, Municipal Corporation, Faridabad, and according to learned counsel for respondent No.2, this writ petition has in fact become infructuous, as the petitioner had already sold the property to one Parmod Sethi in the year 2004, who, in term, has further sold this property to Sandur Sahapathi son of Dr.K.B.Sahapathi vide transfer letter dated 19.11.2007 issued by HUDA, Faridabad and at present, Sandur Sahapathi has been paying water and sewerage charges.

In view of what has been stated by learned counsel for respondent No.2 and the documents duly placed on record by him on the last date of hearing, this writ petition is consigned to the record room with liberty to the parties to get it restored, if need be.
