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Chaudhary Charan Singh, Haryana Agricultural University had terminated the services of respondent No.2-Sh. Mahabir Singh w.e.f. 1.4.1989. The termination was challenged before the Labour Court who had set aside the termination and ordered reinstatement with full back wages from the date of demand notice. That order is the subject matter of the present writ petition at the behest of the University.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced the order of the University dated 22.7.1997 whereby the services of some employees of the University including respondent No.2-Mahabir Singh were regularized from the date they rejoined after the decision of the Court. Respondent-workman had joined on 22.11.1995 after the award was pronounced by the Labour Court. Order has been placed on the file. Learned counsel has also placed on record, the affidavit of Mahabir Singh-respondent in which it is mentioned that he was taken on duty on 22.11.1995 and in view of that he gives up his claim regarding back wages up to 21.11.1995.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner states
that this writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be

disposed of as such.

We order accordingly.

As a matter of abundant caution, we observe that if the respondent has any grievance still left, he may approach the University again for redressal of his grievance.
