Present writ petition is directed against the impugned ejectment order dated 23.6.1988 (Annexure P-1) and three subsequent appellate as well as revisional orders contained in Annexures P-2, to P-4.

It is a matter of record that neither at the time of issuing notice of motion, nor at the time of admission of the writ petition for regular hearing, any interim order was passed. Further, contesting respondents No.5 and 6 in preliminary objection No.1 of their written statement, have stated that during the pendency of the revision petition before the Financial Commissioner, possession of the land in dispute has already been delivered to them, rendering the present writ petition infructuous.

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In view of the abovesaid disputed fact situation obtaining on record, present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. However, on the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner that he is not having the latest instructions from the petitioner, liberty is granted to petitioner to get the present writ petition revived within a period of three months, if necessity arises.

Disposed of, accordingly.
