1. This order will dispose of the above cited cases as common questions of law and fact are involved in them which can conveniently be decided by a common order.

2. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that these petitions have been rendered infructuous for the reason that a large number of writ petitions including CWP No.15669 of 1995 (Punam Rani & ors. v. State of Haryana & ors.) were disposed of as infructuous by the

Division Bench of this Court, by orders pronounced on October 1, 2013. Since identical matters have been rendered infructuous, these petitions also deserve to be disposed of in terms of the order dated October 1, 2013 passed in *Punam Rani* case.

3. In addition thereto, Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal for the respondent State refers to the decision of the Division Bench in Ritesh Dutta & ors. v. State of Haryana & ors., 2012(1) SCT 219: 2012 (1) RSJ 360, to submit that in the matter of determination of minimum qualifications for recruitment of teachers in schools, this Court has held that the Basic Teachers Training Programme of two years duration is necessary qualification and B.Ed. is no substitute for such a course. It is not that in every case higher qualifications will make person more suitable than those possessed with the basic qualifications for teaching junior school and much would depend, on the issue, upon the post and its demands.
