**HIND SAMACHAR LTD V/S THE PRESIDING OFFICER, LABOUR
COURT, JALANDHAR & ANOTHER**

Vide award of the Labour Court dated 22.4.1996 the Labour Court, Jalandhar had awarded a sum of ₹ 8,000/- to the workman against Management (now Petitioner). The Admitting Bench had stayed the operation of the award.

As observed above, the dispute was only of ₹ 8,000/-. On the last date of hearing nobody had appeared on behalf of the parties. Notice was ordered to be issued to respondent No.2-workman. The report is that 'no person of this name works in this newspaper'. Today also nobody is present on behalf of the parties. It seems that parties are not interested in pursuing the matter. In fact, when the case was admitted in 1997 nobody had appeared on behalf of the workman despite service. In view of the aforesaid circumstances, we consider it appropriate to consign the writ petition to records with liberty to the parties/their counsel to get the case revived, in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist.

Writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.
