RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL)

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner on instructions from Ms. Shivani Sharma states that the affidavit as directed may take time since the petitioner is on travel abroad and would return sometime in May, 2016. The petitioner has been apprised of the previous order dated 10th February, 2016 and the proposal made in court on reaching a broad consensus in order to settle the disputes without inviting any decision from the court. Parties are ad idem of the private settlement reached which is therefore not required to be reduced in writing in this order or on affidavit which is no longer found necessary. The disputes stand settled between the parties. Since they are aware of the terms being the architects of the understanding the same shall remain binding on them and no further litigation will be entertained in court on the prayers made in the petition. Both the parties will give effect to that settlement to their mutual advantage. Their statement re: settlement is taken as an undertaking to this Court. This happily brings an end of the dispute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
