This appeal has been filed against the acquittal of the respondent.

As per the allegation the respondent had given a cheque of Rs.1.00 lac to the complainant-applicant-appellant. That cheque having been dishonored the complainant-applicant-appellant filed the instant complaint.

The court has found that against the cheque in question the respondent had given two cheques of Rs.50,000/- each.

Learned counsel for the complainant-applicant-appellant has argued that those cheques were from a different transaction but has accepted that this fact was not mentioned either in the legal notice or in the complaint.

Consequently, I find no reason to take a different view to that taken by the trial Court.

Appeal is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
