RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL)

This order will dispose of the above mentioned two writ petitions, which involve selection and recruitment of Constables in a drive to fill up 1800 vacancies. Both the petitions relate to recruitment in District Hisar. The recruitment was made district-wise. No interim orders were passed in these cases while admitting the matters. It is too late to upset a selection made in 1999 in the year 2016 and no relief can come to the petitioners, which might result in administrative chaos and disturbing of settled rights of a large number of third parties. Therefore, I would not intervene in these matters at this belated stage in a direct recruitment process

which has become a dead ball. It can be said that both the writ petitions have been rendered infructuous by efflux of time. Relief is incapable of being granted.

Consequently, both the petitions are dismissed for the above reasons.
