RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

On six dates after January 21, 2015, no one appeared for the petitioner.

On January 21, 2015, this Court passed the following order:-

“Mr. Mann is granted time to take instructions whether any benefit has been granted to the petitioners in terms of Saroj Rani's case before the matter is taken up for final disposal and to know what is left of the case in terms of relief”.

The State has filed an affidavit of Mr. Shivdular Singh Dhillon, Additional Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Patiala on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 explaining in Paragraph 5 that relief has been granted to the petitioners in terms of decision of the Supreme Court in the case of **Saroj Rani and others vs. State of Punjab**; 1999 (6) SCC 637 which brings the matter to an end. This writ petition stands disposed of in terms of Paragraph 5 of the affidavit filed by Mr. Shivdular Singh on behalf of respondents no.4 to 6.
