The present writ petition is under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the Municipal Committee, Ambala City to provide for basic amenities i.e. sewerage, pacca roads, street lightening and to remove the encroachment upon the areas reserved for parks in sanctioned Town Planning Scheme A-2 Ambala.

The Municipal Committee in the written statement filed on 10.11.1998 had taken the plea that the said scheme was framed under the provisions of Section 192 (3) of the Punjab Municipal Act, 1911 and now this scheme has been turned as Scheme No. 203 under the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973. Their stand is that the petitioner-Sabha has not given a truthful version. 80% roads, water supply, street lights have been completed and further development work is under progress and shall be completed. Four parks were to be developed. There has been a litigation but they are taking projects of Ambala City on priority basis.

We have perused the said averments.

The present writ petition is of the year 1998.

On the last date of hearing learned counsel for the petitioner sought time to take necessary instructions from the petitioner-Sabha to take further action in the matter. However, today he has apprised that the petitioner-Sabha is not responding and perhaps may not be interested to pursue any further.

In these circumstances, let the writ petition be consigned to record room with liberty to the parties to get the case revived in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist.
