By way of present writ petition, petitioner is seeking grant of family pension to the petitioner.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 26.08.2015, petitioner has deposited the payment of CPF on 31.10.2015.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 5 has admitted this fact, however, submits that the petitioner is required to fill form for grant of family pension.

disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to fill up form for grant of family pension and deposit it in the office of respondent No. 5 and thereafter-respondent No. 5 shall pass appropriate orders with regard to grant of family pension to the petitioner, within next three months.
