Sh. Bikkar Singh and Sh. Ajaib Singh filed a writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India wherein the order dated 21.8.1997 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Superintending Canal Officer, Sirhind Canal Circle, Ludhiana relating to 'wara bandi' of Khal (water course). The dispute was in fact with Bakshish Singh and Jeet Singh ss/o Sh. Mukhtiar Singh (respondents No. 4 and 5).

It was felt that since nearly two decades have passed, the matter can be amicably disposed of. Notices were issued to the parties.

Today Sh.Paramjit Singh who is the son of Sh. Bikkar Singh (petitioner No.1) and Sh. Ajaib Singh (petitioner No.2) have put in appearance and made a joint statement endorsed by their counsel Sh.Charanpreet Singh, Advocate that in fact the cause of action had accrued in the year 1997 with the said order for which, the present writ petition had been filed. Now after so many years the said cause of action does not persist and they are getting their share of the water

and as such, they do not want to pursue the present writ petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Sh. Jeet Singh, one of the respondents also endorses that they are getting their share of the water and no dispute is left with the petitioners.

In view of the said situation, since no further cause of action persists and the parties are getting their respective shares of the water course and the petitioners do not want to pursue the present writ petition, the same is dismissed as withdrawn.
