Learned counsel for the State, at the very outset, rightly submits that in view of the nature of controversy involved, coupled with the fact that earlier identical writ petition filed by this very petitioner bearing CWP No.13196 of 1998 having been dismissed by Division Bench of this Court vide order dated 21.03.1998 and there being no interim order in the present writ petition, nothing would survive to be decided, at the hands of this Court, because the licence of the petitioner was restored, barring the sale of only one insecticide namely monocrotophos, manufactured by M/s Unikal Pesticides Private Limited.

In view of the abovesaid undisputed statement made by learned counsel for the State, present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

However, since nobody is present on behalf of the petitioner, liberty is granted to the petitioner to get revived the writ petition within a period of three months, if necessity arises.

Disposed of, accordingly.
