SURINDER GUPTA, J.(Oral)

Learned senior counsel Mr.Sanjay Majithia submits that it is an old appeal of 1988 in which notice was issued on 2.8.1988 and now it has been listed for arguments. During the period after the filing of the appeal, the appellants have not turned up or have contacted him. He has made all his attempts to contact them by sending letters/registered letters but the appellants have not come forward to give any instructions to argue the matter. It is an appeal against the decree of partition and parties may have amicably settled the dispute. In the absence of instructions to address arguments in this appeal, he does not deem it appropriate to appear and argue and request for passing of appropriate orders.

This appeal was filed by Mr.Sanjay Majithia, Advocate in the year 1988. As he pleads no instructions, I am left with no other option but to dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution.
