This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to take action on the complaints Annexure P-3 & P-4 filed by the petitioner against respondent No.4 and thereafter take an action in accordance with law, further issuance of direction to respondent No.1 to take action on the representation Annexure P-6 and thereafter to transfer the enquiry from Moga to Hoshiarpur.

In pursuance of notice of motion issued by this Court, the reply by way of affidavit of Kulwant Singh Heer, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur was filed.

A glance at the aforesaid reply-cum-affidavit transpires that the petitioner moved an application bearing No. 2516-SSP dated July 12, 2012 to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur against respondent No.4

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which was marked to Station House Officer, Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur got conducted enquiry from ASI Jasvir Singh. Finding no substance, the said application was filed by Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur from February 18, 2013. Thereafter, the petitioner submitted another application bearing No. 3797-SSP dated October 17, 2012 to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur against respondent No.4 that application was marked to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur for enquiry. The concerned Deputy Superintendent of Police conducted enquiry and finding no substance, he recommended the filing of the said application. Thereafter, Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur after going through the contents of the enquiry report, filed the said applications. As far as representation (Annexure P-6) is concerned, it has revealed that no such application was received by Hoshiarpur Police. Moreover, the allegations in all the representations are the same out of which Annexures P-3 & P-4 have already been enquired into and filed with the orders of Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur. Since there are similar allegations in Annexure P-6, no fresh enquiry is required.

In view of the submission of above said reply, instant petition has rendered infructuous and same stands disposed of.
