It seems that in this appeal, which was admitted to regular hearing in the year 1988, when it came up for hearing thereafter for the first time on 11.03.2015, i.e. about one and a half years ago, it was noticed that learned Senior Counsel who had appeared for the appellant in the year 1988, had passed away and the instructing counsel was also no longer practicing.

Consequently, notice had been issued to the appellant, returnable on 22.04.2015. Thereafter again on 27.05.2015, fresh notice had been ordered to be issued to the appellant, returnable on 29.07.2015.

As per the report of the Registry, the door of the premises of the appellant was locked at the time when service was attempted to be effected upon him.

Thereafter also it is seen that none appeared for the appellant on 01.09.2016 and 04.11.2016. It seems that the appellant is no longer interested in pursuing the present appeal.

Consequently, it is dismissed for non-prosecution.
