**RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)**

Mr. Birender Singh Rana, learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that this petition has been rendered infructuous on the reasoning that the benefit of stepping up of pay granted to the petitioner would reveal withdrawn by the impugned order and in the same circumstances, in separate proceedings in CWP No.4870 of 1997, decided on July 19, 2001 in Lok Adalat, the benefit was granted to all similarly circumstance employees who were Cottonseeds Processing Operators and this benefit has been granted to the petitioner and duly implemented. It is in this way that the writ petition has been rendered infructuous on account of parallel proceedings ending before the Lok Adalat and duly implemented. The order which renders this petition infructuous is dated November 23, 2001 (Annex P-6).

That brings the dispute to an end. Dismissed as infructuous.
