SNEH PRASHAR, J.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. On the last date of hearing also i.e. 12.01.2016 none appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Perusal of the copy of order dated 15.07.2003 passed by Presiding Officer, Special Court, Kurukshetra shows that an application was filed by the petitioner for taking the Maruti Car No.HNU-1999 on superdari as power of attorney of the registered owner. However, declining his request the registered owner was asked to be produced

personally. Since the registered owner did not appear the application was dismissed vide order dated 04.09.2003. It is worthwhile to note that it was mentioned in the order that the registered owner may file an application for superdari again at any time. When the registered owner had been given the liberty to file an application for taking the vehicle on superdari and it was not the case of the petitioner that the registered owner had died, the instant petition was not maintainable. Otherwise also, since none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, it is hereby dismissed for want of prosecution.
