It is a matter of record that when this case came up for hearing before a Division Bench of this Court on 8.2.1995, present case was ordered to come up after the decision of CWP No. 10840 of 1994 (Muslim Welfare Committee Vs. Union of India and others). CWP No. 10840 of 1994 came to be disposed of by a Division Bench of this Court vide order dated 2.12.2013 and operative part thereof, reads as under:-

“Relief claimed is akin to the relief of permanent injunction. Furthermore, in the written statement, it is stated that in the similar circumstances and in many writ petitions, the petitioners were relegated to the remedy before the Civil Court or any other competent forum. None has put in appearance before this Court on behalf of the petitioner.

The writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail any other remedy, as per law.”

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In view of the abovesaid order passed by the Division Bench of this Court, present writ petition is also ordered to be disposed of, in terms of the order dated 2.12.2013 passed in CWP No. 10840 of 1994.
