This writ petition was filed by B.I.C. Ltd. N.E.W. Mills Dhariwal against the Assistant Collector, Grade-I -cum-Labour and Conciliation Officer and Ranjit Singh (workman). The writ petition was with a prayer for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the demand notice dated 17.01.2001(Annexure P-6) issued by the respondent No. 1 vide which the petitioner had been directed to deposit a sum of ₹ 1,51,991/- (Rs. One Lac Fifty One Thousand Nine Hundred Ninty One Only) payable to respondent No. 2 (workman) under the award of the Labour Court dated 21.08.1998. Respondent No. 2- workman had not appeared when the writ petition was admitted even notice sent now has come back with a report “retired”. This is a 15 years old matter. Respondent No. 2 is not represented nor he has chosen to appear in person.

In view of the above, we consign this writ petition to records with liberty to parties to get the case revived in accordance with law if circumstance, so exist.
