The petitioner was found in possession of 140 tablets of Addnok, allegedly containing Buprenorphine and Naloxone.

Counsel for the petitioner relies upon a prescription slip issued by Retreat Foundation dated 08.12.2015 indicating that on account of de-addiction treatment, the petitioner had been prescribed this medicine.

The report of the Chemical Examiner has not been received as yet and challan has been presented without the said report.

In the aforesaid circumstances, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that petitioner will not indulge in similar activity during the entire period of trial.
