The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.14, dated 25.1.2016, registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149,
506, 326 of the IPC, at Police Station Machhiwara, District Ludhiana.

As per allegations, on 29.1.2016, the petitioners were laying
pipes to drain their waste water into the street and when the complainant

Being the Lambardar objected to this illegality, co-accused Satnam Singh

gave him a datar blow and Manpreet Singh (petitioner No.4) inflicted simple injuries to the complainant's nephew.

Learned counsel for the complainant as well as learned Addl. AG Punjab have fairly accepted that there are no allegations against petitioners No.1 to 3, while simple injury is attributed to petitioner No.4-Manpreet Singh.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Consequently, this petition is allowed and the order dated 18.3.2016 is made absolute.
