The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 254 dated 09.11.2015 registered at Police Station Rajpura City, District Patiala under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B, 380 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record statement given by the victim. He contends that the petitioner is in custody since 21.11.2015 and the girl refused to accompany her mother and is now lodged in Nari Niketan and it was a case of run away marriage. Counsel refers to the affidavit, photographs and the petition filed before the Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate Barh (Patna).

Learned State counsel urges that some additional accused were summoned who failed to appear and P.O. Proceedings have been initiated against them.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
