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Perusal of file shows that detailed order dated 23.05.2003 was passed by the Hon'ble High Court against Civil Misc. No.11803-04-C of 2005. However, again an order was passed by the Hon'ble High Court on 02.02.2006, which reads as under:-

“The appeal already stands disposed of. No further order is called for. However, this order will be without prejudice to any other remedy of the appellant-applicant.

Civil Misc. No.11804-C of 2005 is disposed of.”

Hence, in view of the aforesaid order that the appeal already stands disposed of and Civil Misc. was also disposed of, the present appeal does not survive. Hence, no further order is required to be passed in this appeal by the Lok Adalat.

Though it has been stated by learned counsel for the appellant that notice may be issued to the respondents, however, in view of the aforesaid order dated 02.02.2006, we do not feel that any notice is required to be given to the respondents.

Hence, as the appeal already stands disposed of, matter be consigned to the record.
