Learned State counsel on instructions submits that in compliance of order dated 30.03.2016 the petitioner has joined the investigation and the prosecutrix has refused to get her medical done whereas accusations have been made after 40 days of the incident. The petitioner is the neighbour.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 30.03.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
