FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner Gurdip Singh has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.61 dated 11.09.2015 registered at Police Station Smalsar, Moga under Sections 363/366-A/120-B IPC.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 21.03.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and has adequately cooperated and which facts have been duly acceded to by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh and submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that the State has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.03.2016 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
