By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.96, dated 13.10.2015, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar Sunam, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states in pursuance of the order dated 21.03.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel informs that though the petitioner has joined investigation, however, the recovery

of alleged amount is yet to be effected.

The amount involved in the instant FIR is covered by the undertaking of the Managing Director of the company whose bail petition has been dismissed. Since the undertaking made before this Court by main accused lacks *bona fide*, therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of bail.
