This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.3 dated 30.01.2016, registered under Section 420 IPC, at Police Station NRI, District Jalandhar (Rural).

On 21.03.2016 the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered at the instance of Mehar Singh alleging that share of co-sharer

of Amarjit Kaur has been sold to Sarabjit Kaur with specific boundaries.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that dispute if any is of civil nature.

On asking of the Court, counsel for the petitioner informs that there is no civil litigation pending regarding the property in dispute.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab, for 18.5.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on 9.4.2016. In case of petitioner doing so, she will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. ”

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Manoj Kumar has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 21.03.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
