JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner-Tara Chand in case FIR No. 97, dated 08.09.2015, for the offences punishable under Sections 379, 411, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 472, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bahaw Wala, District Fazilka (**Annexure P-1**).

The petitioner is alleged to be a part of Gang, committing theft of luxury vehicles from the State of Punjab and more than sixty stolen vehicles from the Gang were recovered.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Kala Singh, submits that recovery of vehicles worth Rs.2 Crores has been effected from the petitioner and there are 07 other FIRs against the petitioner. She further submits that challan stands presented, however, charges are yet to be framed.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
