The petitioner having not been attributed any specific injury and the challan having been presented, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar subject to the condition that the petitioner will not indulge in the

similar offence of which he is accused of during the period of trial.
