Prayer in this petition is for extension of time for furnishing bail bonds before the learned Area/Duty Magistrate pursuant to order dated 19.2.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that since the petitioner had suffered with blood infection, he could not appear and furnish the requisite bail bonds before the Sessions Court at Sri Muktsar Sahib.
