Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.78 dated 17.12.2015, under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is 60 kgs. of poppy husk.

Petitioner was arrested on 21.12.2015.

Investigation in the case is complete and even challan stands presented. Charges have also been framed.

The trial is stated to be at the very initial stage.

The alleged recovery effected from the petitioner would be construed as marginally over and above the commercial quantity. Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

In view of the above, the prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
