Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.110 dated 12.11.2015, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

During the course of arguments, it stands conceded that the alleged recovery of microlit tablets containing diphenoxylate hydrochloride salt would reckoned as non-commercial quantity.

Investigation in the case is complete and even challan stands presented.

Petitioner has suffered incarceration since 12.11.2015.

Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Without making any observations on merits, the present petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
