Petitioners are wife and husband. They have filed this petition for a blanket bail on the ground that brother of petitioner No.1 being married to respondent No.5 and there being a matrimonial discord between them, respondent No.5 has filed certain frivolous complaints to harass the petitioners, as such, they may be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Without expression of any opinion regarding the reasonableness of apprehension, I am of the considered opinion that in the interest of judicial propriety, the petitioners could have filed a similar petition before the Sessions Court, Kaithal.

This petition is disposed of relegating the petitioners to the alternative remedy of approaching the Sessions Court.
