This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.62 dated 15.04.2014 registered under Sections 307/458/324/326/426/148/149 IPC at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 15.01.2015 and the complainant is not turning

up to give evidence because he is a proclaimed offender in a case under Section 302 IPC registered against him.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Anokh Singh has argued that the petitioner and (as a matter of fact the complainant) are hardcore criminals and the petitioner had chopped the arm of the complainant above the elbow.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
