Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Ikattar Singh in case FIR No.21 dated 12.02.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 170, 197, 419, 420 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana.

The allegations against the petitioner-accused are that he projects himself to be a doctor with MBBS, MD, PCMS-I qualifications and uses such stamps for issuance of fake medical certificates. Photocopy of one of such fake certificate forms part of the police file in FIR No.335 of 2005 P.S. Division No.5, Ludhiana. It is also alleged that the Civil Surgeon has reported that the petitioner-accused is not registered with Punjab Medical Council.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, keeping in

view the nature of the allegations, it is evident that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner would be required for completing the chain of investigation, therefore, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
